Mentor Reminders:

A. New entry policies – During the past few weeks we have seen some dramatic changes to the entry procedures at Walker SP. These are occurring across the state of Georgia and are not unique to Walker. Please be patient as these new procedures are "ironed out" and realize that we are "quests" of the prison and must abide by all the rules and regulations that they require. Some of the recent changes that we all must remember;

- 1. You must have a card issued by your doctor if you have any metal implants that will set-off the metal detector. Failure to have such a card may prevent entry.
- 2. Your GDC volunteer photo ID badge must have a valid expiration date. Should you try to enter with an expired badge you may be declined.
- 3. Medications, lip balm, cough drops, sore throat lozenges, etc. may not be taken into the prison unless prior authorization is obtained. If you try to take such items inside you may be asked to leave them in your car OR denied access. Prior authorization can be obtained via your group leader.
- 4. You must be listed on the proper weekday on the entry list at the bunker. Failure to notify your group leader of a proposed weekday change may result in denied access when you try to enter the prison. You are only authorized to enter on a particular weekday.
