

FAMILY DAY 2016 UPDATE: Family Day at Walker State Prison (WSP) is an unbelievable event where the offenders can invite their family, including children, to spend the day with them. This "picnic-like" event is held outside (weather permitting) and currently has ~1,300 men, women, and children registered to attend. There will be music, games, inflatable amusements for the children, and many other activities that will turn the WSP ball field into a virtual "county fair." The prison administration allows mentors to serve as "family" for those mentoring partners that do not have family planning to attend; otherwise the offender would not get to participate in this event. Mentors whose mentoring partners have invited family may still attend and serve as "volunteers" to perform certain tasks needed to support this great event. These "volunteer" mentors then have a chance to meet their mentees' families. Our ministry currently has 30 mentors & wives registered to serve as "family" with an additional 29 mentors & wives serving as "volunteers." Please plan to arrive on this Friday, Sept. 23rd, morning as indicated below:

LESSONS LEARNED:

- Forwarding JPay E-mail Recently, a mentor received an e-mail through JPay and was asked by his mentoring partner to forward the e-mail to other individuals not involved in this ministry. The JPay e-mail system is set-up to prevent the offenders from sending e-mails to "free world" individuals without prior approval. Having a mentor send such an e-mail disables this important safeguard. To help protect the integrity of the mentoring ministry, mentors should avoid contacting individuals on behalf of their mentoring partners through any medium.
- **Providing Money (\$) to an Offender's Account** Following a question from a mentor involving possible financial support of his mentoring partner by the mentor's church, we learned that GDC policy prevents an organization from putting money on an offender's account. To be eligible to put money on an offender's account, the person must be an approved visitor on the offender's visitation list. A mentor cannot be on his mentee's visitation list. Additionally, a request such as this falls into the realm of personal dealings by the mentor. We should not try to find organizations to donate or help facilitate the transfer of money onto our mentoring partner's account. If your mentoring partner is indigent, your best way of supporting him financially is to donate either material or money (\$) to the "Home Project." This allows the chaplaincy to feed and provide hygiene products to those offenders in need. We collect items or money for the "Home Project" at each of our Fellowship Breakfasts.
