Mentor Contributions to Indigent Prisoners. You donated \$1,440 for 125 special care bags to prisoners over Christmas. There was about \$250 remaining after expenses that was sent to the prison in cash.

WARNING About Over-Identifying with Your Mentee. "My mentee and I have been together 4-1/2 yrs. It is the most personal male friendship I ever have had. It is so 'normal' with an investment in each other so personal, it is easy to forget he is a prisoner with a life sentence. In recent months, I let down my guard. Easily I could have crossed the line by communicating directly with family, getting involved in legal / parole issues, passing items of value, sending J-Pay stamps in bulk, even putting money on his books. I was tempted to forget rules as I would only have been doing what Christian brothers do for one another." DON'T DO IT!!! It is the fastest way to be removed from ministry, have your mentee shipped, and the ministry put on probation, with potentially severe consequences and retraction of our privileges to serve there. This is MY testimony. I confessed it to my mentee, and discussed it with Mark Casson, Doug Craven, and Chap Stroop. If you have your own questions or doubts, ask. Alan Bonderud
